#### PRESENTATION OF ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2007-08

Apart from this Movie show for the Blind was organized jointly with RT 4. The Table also donated for Kidney transplant & Cancer patient. The total project done during the year was worth Rs. 11,89,336.

Many theme based socials such as Holi, Diwali, Pirates of Carribean, Walk like Egyptian, Sham-e-Awadh, Beijing Olympics, South Indian, Bachpan and Masquerade were hosted. There were 41ers night out, movie outings, tablers night out, discos etc. were a way of life at 34. Valentine's day celebrations, Night out at Sohos, coffee meets were held. Anniversaries and Birthdays were never forgotten and always celebrated in style. Bagbaan-the grand parents day was once again celebrated in style. The outstation trip to Raichak . The "Koffee with Kaun" tradition was renamed " Hum Tum aur Kaun " and carried forward with a twist . Now , a Couple from other Table was also invited and it helped strengthen intra table as well as inter table bonds. 
